Speed Humps on Forest Run?

There have been numerous newsletter articles discussing the problem of speeding and driving on the wrong side of the islands along Forest Run Drive. For those who have corrected this behavior, it is much appreciated by homeowners along Forest Run. However, it continues to be a significant problem. Numerous homeowners continue to complain about illegal driving.

Please know that homeowners are reporting violations to the police in hopes of increasing patrols in our neighborhood. All homeowners are encouraged to report illegal activity. It's not as important to get plate numbers and/or addresses as it is to make a complaint with the police. Patrols are assigned by the number of complaints within a specific region. **Call the police at 409-2200** and report what you are seeing - don't assume it will be handled by others.

Homeowners concerned with this behavior have started a petition to have speed humps installed on Forest Run to curb this behavior. The board would prefer not to add speed humps, and expects that a majority of homeowners do not want speed humps either. However, if violators do not stop driving illegally on Forest Run the option of adding speed humps will be seriously considered. This is your chance to prevent that from happening. Talk with your neighbors, talk with your visitors, and talk with your kids - make sure everyone knows that driving behavior in Wickham Forest is being monitored at all times.

Driving illegally around the islands saves only a few seconds. Are these seconds so important that you are willing to risk having speed humps installed so that safety can be upheld in our neighborhood? Please be respectful of your neighbors, and obey the traffic laws in our subdivision on all streets. This is a warning and chance to make a difference!

Parking in Wickham Forest

Some homeowners may wonder why parking on the streets and/or lawns is not allowed. Parking on the streets and/or lawns has been such a problem in the past, creating safety issues for the entire neighborhood. There have been situations where ambulances, fire trucks, and/or garbage trucks have had trouble getting past cars parked in the street when on route. That is a major reason why the board has taken such a stringent viewpoint on parking violations. While a vehicle parked on the grass doesn't impede traffic, it is listed as a violation under our parking covenants and therefore must be enforced as stringently as vehicles parked on the street. The board tries to use common-sense when enforcing parking violations, as sometimes a homeowner must use the street to park cars temporarily. Vehicles should never be parked on the lawn.

As of January 1st The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) adopted rules designed to prevent last minute closing surprises. In the past it was not uncommon for a buyer to go to closing and find that the lender's good faith estimate did not agree with the closing statement. The HUD's closing fees were much higher than the lender had quoted and the buyer had 2 choices: walk away and start searching for another house or pony up.

Lenders are now required to use a UNIFORM three-page document when they give prospective borrowers a good faith estimate (GFE). Lenders are also required to provide the document within 72 hours after prospective borrowers apply for a loan. This will allow consumers to figure out a loan's total cost, including fees, and compare loan offers on an apple-to-apple basis. It encourages consumers to shop for the best rates and fees, not just the best rate. As I said last month the lowest interest rate is not always the best deal.

Some lenders offer borrowers a lower interest rate in exchange for higher upfront costs or vice versa. A new table in the GFE helps borrowers compare how different interest rates and settlement charges will affect monthly payments.

The new rules will make it much more difficult for lenders to depart from their GFE. The new HUD-1 includes a line-by-line comparison to the good faith estimate making it easy to identify any change in costs.

HUD has published a guide for home buyers, SHOPPING FOR YOUR HOME LOAN: HUD'S SETTLEMENT COST BOOKLET. You can find it at www.hud.gov. I encourage anyone who is purchasing a home to read this document. It is important for you to know how much your closing fees are and where they are going.

The Wickham Forest ARC suggests that if you are planning to paint your home a color that is different from the existing color, that you paint a minimum of a 3 X 3 foot swatch of your planned color on the house. In this way, you will have a better idea of the true shade of the color you are planning to use. Sample paint containers can be obtained for a minimal cost, and will save you from choosing a color that is not what you had intended.

Please make sure you submit an ARC request form and wait for approval before beginning any exterior remodeling project.

WELCOME NEW RESIDENTS



The board would like to welcome any new residents to our community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any board member. We will be happy to assist you in any way we can.

A few reminders regarding our Covenants, for those who do not have a copy —

1. **Yard trash is picked up on Mondays.** Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Big piles of yard debris are difficult to handle and will not be picked up. Yard debris not picked up on Mondays will require that the homeowner call Waste Management themselves to arrange for a special pickup at no cost to the homeowner. It is suggested that the homeowner also call a board member to notify them that a pickup has been scheduled. For information, contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
2. **Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Fridays.** Garbage containers/recycling bins should not be placed at the curb until 5pm the night before pick up. Garbage containers/recycling bins must be stored as not to be visible from the street or adjacent property within sight distance of the lot.
3. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval **BEFORE** starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval.
