ARC GUIDELINES

on updating the official color book. The guidelines used by the ARC for evaluating color schemes essentially remains intact, conforming to the guidelines in the Official Color Book for house, trim and accent (i.e. the front door). The selected colors need to be considered in relation to:
Any brick or stone colorColor of adjacent homes
□ Compatibility of house and trim colors
When submitting a request for house painting to the ARC the homeowner needs to include: Color name, number and manufacturer(if your color choice is already on a home somewhere in the neighborhood the ARC chair can provide you with this information) along with a sample of colors attached to the form. Color garage door is to be painted Fascia, soffit and rain gutter color, if applicable(generally, these are left white, unless the trim is a pale neutral that matches the roof)
□. Front door color, if applicable
In most cases, if new or unusual color combinations are being requested, samples of such color will need to be painted on the house so they can be evaluated for conformity to the standards. A tiny swatch of color in the paint store under fluorescent light may seem lovely, however, when it covers a whole house it can become overwhelming.
Some helpful tips when preparing to select house colors:
□ Non pastel shades and tones of a color look better with a white or cream trim.
□ Garage doors are not considered trim and should generally be painted the house color (doing so tends to make the house look larger) with the exception of: If the house is a deeper tone with white trim, the garage door can be the trim color. If the house is painted a light or medium shade of a single color (I.e. A light grey and a medium grey) the garage door can be painted the trim color.
 □ Houses with double trim bands: □ Paint both bands the same color □ Paint them two shades of the same color □ Do not paint unrelated colors.

City of Melbourne Notices

City Council Approves New Restrictions on Fertilizer Use

Melbourne, **Fla.**, **Sept. 12**, **2014** — Last night the City Council approved changes to strengthen the ordinance regulating fertilizer use within the City of Melbourne.

The City's fertilizer ordinance now includes the following restrictions:

- 1) A ban on fertilizer application during the summer rainy season (June 1 to September 30).
- 2) A ban on the use of fertilizer within 15 feet of any surface waters, including, ponds, streams, watercourses, lakes, canals, or wetlands (the previous fertilizer-free zone was 10 feet).
- 3) The percentage of slow release nitrogen content in any fertilizer used must be at least 50%.
- 4) Only phosphate-free fertilizer may be used (with certain exceptions).

In addition, the ordinance calls for a low-maintenance zone of 25 feet adjacent to surface waters that is planted and managed in order to minimize the need for fertilization, watering and mowing. Fertilizer nutrients, such as phosphorus and nitrogen, have been identified as one of the most harmful sources of pollution in the Indian River Lagoon. In March 2013, the City's adopted an ordinance regulating fertilizer use that was based on a model ordinance issued by the State of Florida. However, since it was enacted additional studies have demonstrated the need for more stringent regulations in order to improve the health of the lagoon.

All municipalities in Brevard County have enacted similar restrictions on fertilizer use. In addition, several municipalities along the Indian River Lagoon in Volusia, Indian River, Martin, and St. Lucie counties have adopted stricter ordinances.

"Taking a regional approach to polluted runoff affecting the 156-mile-long Indian River Lagoon with uniform ordinances will go a long way in protecting the water from nutrient runoff," said Melbourne City Engineer Jenni Lamb.

Adoption of a strong fertilizer ordinance is part of the City of Melbourne's comprehensive plan for reducing nutrient loading into the Indian River Lagoon. The plan also includes improvements to the City's stormwater drainage system; treating runoff through a system of retention facilities, baffle boxes, wetlands, rain gardens, and exfiltration systems; collecting stormwater fees to finance the program; cooperating with the St. Johns River Water Management District in regulating stormwater discharge; and working with Brevard County on stormwater treatment and public education projects.

The board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any board member.

A few reminders regarding our Covenants, for those who do not have a copy —

- 1. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management.
- 2. **Bulk Items:** You do not need to call Waste Management to schedule a pickup bulk items (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will make note of the address and return later in the day to pick up bulk items. They will be automatically picked up as long as nothing was longer than 4 ft.; the same as yard trash. information, contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 3. **<u>Electronics:</u>** You still need to call to arrange a special pick up for appliances and electronics.
- 4. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Wednesday. Garbage containers/recycling bins should not be placed at the curb until 5pm the night before pick up. Garbage containers/recycling bins must be stored as not to be visible from the street or adjacent property within sight distance of the lot.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval **BEFORE** starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval.

Yard waste reminder In the recent past our yard waste pick up date was changed from the very convenient Monday to Friday, however the covenants have not changed.' Trash and yard waste shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pick up.' Most yard waste can be held in a trash can or two that can be kept screened from sight until Thursday evening. It only takes a few moments to haul a garbage can to the curb. If very large amounts of yard waste need to be removed the city should be called to schedule a special pick up. If you hire someone to trim your trees/shrubs they are required to haul the debris away. Unlicensed/uninsured vendors may not provide complete service and could present possible legal problems for the homeowner
