Gardening Notes for Winter

In winter, many of our trees and shrubs go dormant for a while. January and February are the perfect time to prune them (for winter and early spring bloomers, wait until after they have flowered).

This is also a good time for planting annuals that won't mind a light frost and herbs and vegetables that enjoy the cooler weather. As our winters can also be very dry, such plantings need regular watering and fertilizer to thrive.

Our lawns slow down as well now and do not need fertilizer. Mowing will help to keep weeds in check, if necessary, large patches can be treated with an herbicide made for your lawn type. This is also the time to attend to brown patch disease, which is a type of fungus. Most garden centers should be able to help you select the correct product for your lawn.

As you care for your property, please be considerate of our neighborhood and wait until Thursday to place your waste to the curb.

Also, one resident reports an analysis of unhealthy St Augustine showed a deficiency in iron in the soil. It was recommended to apply Epson Salts (provides magnesium) along with an Ironnite.

Yard waste reminder

Yard waste is collected by the City on Friday. WF covenants regarding yard waste have not changed. Trash and yard waste shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, the evening before scheduled pick up.

If very large amounts of yard waste need to be removed, the city should be called (321.953.6302 as located on page 6 of this newsletter) to schedule a special pick up. If you hire someone to trim your trees/shrubs they are required to haul the debris away. Unlicensed/uninsured vendors may not provide complete service and could present possible legal problems for the homeowner.

Recycle reminder

PLEASE keep in mind that recycling is picked up by an automated truck. Therefore, only items in the bin can be picked up.

<u>Due to the recent increase of yard waste and garbage being placed at the curb, the HOA will be issuing fines to homeowners that disregard this covenant</u>

WELCOME NEW RESIDENTS

The board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any board member.

A few reminders regarding our Covenants, for those who do not have a copy —

- 1. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management.
- 2. **Bulk Items:** You do not need to call Waste Management to schedule a pickup bulk items (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will make note of the address and return later in the day to pick up bulk items. They will be automatically picked up as long as nothing was longer than 4 ft.; the same as yard trash. information, contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 3. **Electronics:** You still need to call to arrange a special pick up for appliances and electronics.
- 4. **Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Wednesday.** Garbage containers/recycling bins should not be placed at the curb until 5pm the night before pick up. Garbage containers/recycling bins must be stored as not to be visible from the street or adjacent property within sight distance of the lot.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval **BEFORE** starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO HOMEOWNERS REGARDING LEASES All WFHOA

homeowners were asked in February 2014 to vote on an amendment to the WFHOA Declaration of Covenants. The Amendment to the WFHOA Declaration of Covenants passed by a majority vote. Please refer to your copy that was mailed to you in June 2014 for your files. This information can also be located online at wickhamforest.com, under covenants, sec11.1. The Amendment requires all WFHOA landlords to submit a copy of each lease agreement to the WFHOA Board in a timely manner. While most WF landlords have complied, a few lease copies are still outstanding. If you are a landlord, please make certain to comply with the directives as quickly as possible to avoid incurring fines. If you have a second address but your property is NOT leased or rented, please notify the board with that information, as well. Just Say No to Plastic Bags in Your Recycling Carts

When you put out your recycling, take care not to place your recycling in plastic bags. Not only are plastic bags bad for the environment, these bags can create all sorts of problems in the recycling system.

The first problem occurs at the materials recovery facility sorting station. Workers go through tons of material and don't have time to open plastic bags to determine if they contain recyclable products or garbage. This means valuable resources will not be reclaimed. Instead, they will end up in the landfill.

The next issue with plastic bags is that they interfere with the automatic sorting machines if some of the bags are missed by the workers at the sorting station. Conveyor belts feed the recycling into rotating tunnels, onto spinning wheels and past magnets and eddy currents to separate the plastic, paper, glass, aluminum and steel cans. Plastic bags cannot be sorted with existing machinery. Instead, they get caught up in the conveyor belts and jam spinning wheels which can bring the entire sorting station to a halt. The bags then need to be found and removed by hand- a time consuming and often dangerous process that reduces the efficiency of the MRF.

If you like to place your recyclables in bags, make sure they are paper bags. Carry reusable bags with you for shopping. If you do have plastic bags and would like to recycle them, many grocery stores and other big box stores have recycling containers specifically for plastic bags.
