Don't wait for someone else to tell you when you need to attend to your property. The board does not enjoy sending out violation notices, and never singles out specific homeowners for violations. When purchasing in Wickham Forest, we all knew we were buying in a deed restricted community and as such would be held to a higher standard. We, as homeowners, should be proud of our own homesteads and want to keep them and all property values in Wickham Forest as high as possible!

## A Message from the 2nd Vice-President



Wickham Forest is a deed restricted community, which means homeowners must follow all the rules and covenants, even if the covenants seem to be restrictive. When residents become lax in taking care of their property, violation letters are sent out to address these violations. These letters are not sent to irritate, but as a reminder to maintain the community and individual property values.

On a regular basis, homeowners should step out to inspect their own properties. Good property management includes cleaning all mildew/rust from your property, including house, roof, gutters, roof facia, fence, driveway, sidewalks and the curb, street gutters and storm drains, weeding flower beds, trimming shrubs and trees, mowing and edging regularly, painting when it starts to peel or fade, and putting garbage cans away promptly. Corner lot homes are responsible for cleaning all the way around their property line. Neglecting any of the above areas not only affects your home's curb appeal, but also that of your neighborhood. These are all things everyone can do regularly for good property management.

Keep in mind that any exterior updates or changes, including paint or major repairs, need to be approved by ARC prior to beginning the project.

Time spent by board members to inspect all 317 homes and mail out letters adds an additional expense for the HOA. By keeping an eye on the issues around your home you will help Wickham Forest to maintain some of the lowest annual dues in north Melbourne.

In summary, it is the goal of the Wickham Forest Homeowner's Association to maintain the high quality of all properties within our community. Our neighborhood is aging, and because it is, we need to be more persistent in the upkeep of our properties. When homeowners take care of their property, it shows potential new homeowners that people care about their homes, and helps to increase property values.



## **Welcome New Residents!**

The board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any board member at wickham-forest@googlegroups.com.

A few reminders regarding our Community and Covenants:

- 1. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Wednesdays. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept on any Lot except in sanitary containers or garbage compactor units. Garbage containers, if any, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be so placed or screened as not to be visible from any road or adjacent property within sight distance of the Lot. **Trash, refuse and garbage shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pickup.**
- 2. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Waste Management will NOT pick up any yard trash in plastic bags.
- 3. For Bulk Items: Contact Waste Management to schedule a bulk items pick up (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will return later in the day to pick up bulk items. For more information contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 4. Waste Management trucks are automated, maned by only one employee. Therefore, any trash NOT in the garbage bin WILL NOT be picked up.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, to include Roofs and Fences, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval BEFORE starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval, regardless of the current color.
