Homeowners living on the retention ponds have complained to the Board about people wandering in their backyards or cutting through their yards to access the ponds. It is never appropriate to travel through someone's yard for any reason, violating the privacy of other homeowners or residents. Please be considerate of your neighbors and avoid intruding on the property of others.

Wickham Forest ponds are NOT to be used for fishing, as they are part of the St. Johns Water District conservation and flood prevention, and are directly linked to the Indian River Lagoon. There are signs indicating this on the ponds, and others will be added in the near future.

Please be reminded that the Wickham Forest Board members, and those participating on the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) are all volunteers. We ask that you show kindness and respect when communicating with those who serve the Wickham Forest Community when you call, text, or email regarding any issue. While the Board welcomes your input and inquiries, angry words, inappropriate language and threats are not at all necessary or appreciated. You are always welcome to participate in meetings, or to volunteer to serve your neighborhood in any capacity.

The next Wickham Forest Board meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 17, 2021 at 7pm. It will be held at Joe's Club, just north of our entrance to Wickham Forest on the west side of Wickham. This allows us more room for homeowners to attend. See you there!!

The Board will meet for a brief budget meeting to prepare for 2022 following the monthly meeting.

October 2021 Board Meeting

October 20, 2021

Minutes

Nancy called the meeting to order at 7:00PM with a quorum of four board members present.

Secretary's minutes from the last meeting in June 2021 were approved as published in the July newsletter. Financial reports for June - September, as published in the July - October newsletters were approved.

Plans for landscaping at the entrance, Message Board, and islands on Forest Run were discussed. Prolawn will fill the Message Board planter with soil, and poinsettias will be placed there for the holidays. In late winter/early spring when the weather is cooler and the chance of cold weather damage has passed, new plantings will be added to entrance, Message Board, and Forest Run islands.

Closing of the bike paths is still on hold. The City of Melbourne has said no, but other avenues are being explored that may allow closure.

There is no confirmed date from BSE to inspect the ponds and weirs despite continued efforts to have the inspection completed.

The Wickham Forest Covenants currently have very strong rules about requiring ARC approval for changing ANY landscaping on properties. The ARC has suggested that the wording be changed so that only major relandscaping would need ARC approval in the future. This would be a Covenant change, requiring a vote of homeowners. The ARC and Board will work together to draft a rewording of the Covenants concerning landscaping to be included on the ballot for 2022.

Recently, many homeowners have removed, or asked to remove trees from their properties for various reasons. While the City of Melbourne does not have a 'remove a tree, plant a tree' policy, it is desirable that Wickham Forest would not become barren of trees. The ARC will be asked to strongly recommend planting replacement trees when they send out approvals for tree removals.

Update from the February 2021 Annual Meeting Minutes: The WF Board approval of the ARC Color Book was inadvertently omitted from the February 19, 2021 Annual Board Meeting minutes. The secretary of the Board sincerely apologizes for this error.

The Board approved ARC committee addition John Berard as alternate to the ARC. An additional member will be needed as chairman, Nestor Colon, has tendered his resignation at the end of 2021. Contact the Board if you are interested in serving.

A "No Trespassing" sign has been installed at the lift station due to drug paraphernalia being found on the site. Research to be done on the feasibility of adding a solar powered motion detector light at the lift station to deter trespassers. Also checking to see if its possible to mount it on the existing pole. Approval may be needed by the county or FPL to do this.

Speeding on Forest Run continues to be a problem for homeowners living there. All homeowners and residents are reminded that the speed limit on ALL roads in Wickham Forest is 25mph. Reminders are posted monthly in the newsletter.

Efforts will be made to inquire about painting reflective paint on the curbs of the Forest Run islands.

Suggestion to publish names of new residents to Wickham Forest was declined by the Board due to current social situations.

The job description and responsibilities of the Board's Administrative Assistant were reviewed. The current employee is doing a fantastic, outstanding job at a cost much less than that of a property management company. And like a property management company, is not required to live in Wickham Forest to hold that position.

Pepper trees on neighboring property at the entrance are overtaking WF shrubs. Contact to the property owner has been unsuccessful. A call will be made to the county extension office and Melbourne Code Enforcement to ask for assistance in contacting the owner, and what can be done to alleviate this intrusion. It is estimated that cost would be \$2,500 - 3,000 for removal of the intruding vegetation.

A recent inquiry by a homeowner regarding mailboxes was addressed. There is nothing in the Covenants regarding mailboxes in Wickham Forest.

Budget needs for 2022 need to be given to the Treasurer. Budget meeting will be held in November.

Overnight parking was discussed. Reminder to all residents/homeowners that overnight parking on the streets is not permitted in Wickham Forest.

No fishing or swimming is permitted in the ponds in Wickham Forest. Due to recent fishing activity, signs will be placed at the Bent Pine pond on sides adjacent to Sherwood and the railroad. Please respect the privacy of homeowners on the ponds by not walking through their yards.

Holiday decorations at the entrance this year will include a swag with lights at the entrance, and poinsettias there, and around the Message Board.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:30PM.

The next Wickham Forest Board meeting will be held Wednesday, November 17th at 7:00pm, followed immediately by the Board's 2022 Budget Meeting. Check the November newsletter for location.

Welcome New Residents!

The board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any board member at wickham-forest@googlegroups.com.

A few reminders regarding our Community and Covenants:

- 1. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Wednesdays. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept on any Lot except in sanitary containers or garbage compactor units. Garbage containers, if any, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be so placed or screened as not to be visible from any road or adjacent property within sight distance of the Lot. Trash, refuse and garbage shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pickup.
- 2. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Waste Management will NOT pick up any yard trash in plastic bags. If you have very large piles of branches and clippings, always call Waste Management ahead of Friday pickup to notify that you have a large amount. ALSO CALL DAVID AMBROSE—City of Melbourne Manager of the Waste Management contract. (321) 608-5081.
- 3. For Bulk Items: Contact Waste Management to schedule a bulk items pick up (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will return later in the day to pick up bulk items. For more information contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 4. Waste Management trucks are automated, manned by only one employee. Therefore, any trash NOT in the garbage bin WILL NOT be picked up.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, to include Roofs and Fences, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval BEFORE starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval, regardless of the current color.
