Every resident needs to cooperate and work together to keep our neighborhood neat and uncluttered. Recently, some have placed large, bulky household items such as grills and refrigerators curbside prior to the scheduled Friday pick-up day. Please remember that the City of Melbourne sets the schedule and rules regarding waste collection. The doors of appliances need to be either removed or taped/secured shut. Either one is acceptable and most people tape them shut. And refrigerators must have no food inside. ALL residents need to follow those rules.

Remember, too, that you MUST contact Waste Management at (321) 723-4455 to schedule the collection of bulk items such as furniture, appliances and mattresses. You cannot assume that they will automatically be picked up on Friday. Call to confirm the date that Waste Management will pick up your items. This is the only way to insure collection. DO NOT place them curbside prior to 5:00pm the evening before your confirmed collection date. January 2021 Board Meeting

January 20, 2021

Minutes

Nancy called the meeting to order at 7:02PM with a quorum of all board members present.

Secretary's minutes from the October 2020 Board Meeting, as published in the November Newsletter, were approved.

Financial report for October, as published in the November newsletter, was approved.

Mary reported that the mulching has been completed at the entrance and Wood Haven islands, but the Forest Run islands still need to be mulched and will be completed in the near future. The contracted cost for mulching will increase next year. Mary will review the contract with Prolawn to be specific about the frequency of weeding and trimming.

New entrance lighting will be evaluated to be sure it was completed as requested.

Plans for landscaping at the entrance, Message Board, and Forest Run islands was tabled until the spring planting season. The company to do the stonework planter around the Message Board backed out, so Mary will search for another vendor.

The Board voted unanimously to close both bike paths. This will deter unwelcome visitors from entering our neighborhood on foot. The Board reviewed estimates from three companies and chose to contact one of them to complete the work.

Bob Bruno from the ARC reported that the color chips for the new ARC Color Book have been chosen. It now needs to be assembled and compiled. Janet offered to assist with that task, planning for it to be completed to present at the Annual Meeting in February.

All Board members have signed and submitted the Board Member Certification.

Preparations for Wickham Forest Annual Homeowner's meeting on February 17 are completed.

A homeowner present at the meeting inquired about the fence option question on the Annual Ballot. It was previously determined that homeowners would need to vote to amend the Covenants regarding fence options. The decision to put it to a homeowner vote was based on numerous complaints about mildewed and aging fences in the neighborhood that are unsightly.

Homeowners are also reminded that conservation areas may not be cut down, only trash can be removed from those areas. Vegetation from the conservation areas that is growing onto a homeowner's property may be trimmed back, but not removed.

The next WFHOA meeting, the Annual Homeowner's Meeting will be held Wednesday, February 17, 2021 at 7pm at the Holiday Inn Conference Center, Wickham Road/195.

Meeting adjourned at 7:50pm.





Welcome New Residents!

The board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any board member at wickham-forest@googlegroups.com.

A few reminders regarding our Community and Covenants:

- 1. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Wednesdays. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept on any Lot except in sanitary containers or garbage compactor units. Garbage containers, if any, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be so placed or screened as not to be visible from any road or adjacent property within sight distance of the Lot. **Trash, refuse and garbage shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pickup.**
- 2. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Waste Management will NOT pick up any yard trash in plastic bags. If you have very large piles of branches and clippings, always call Waste Management ahead of Friday pickup to notify that you have a large amount. ALSO CALL DAVID AMBROSE—City of Melbourne Manager of the Waste Management contract. (321) 608-5081.
- 3. For Bulk Items: Contact Waste Management to schedule a bulk items pick up (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will return later in the day to pick up bulk items. For more information contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 4. Waste Management trucks are automated, maned by only one employee. Therefore, any trash NOT in the garbage bin WILL NOT be picked up.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, to include Roofs and Fences, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval BEFORE starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval, regardless of the current color.
