This year, the Florida legislature has reinstated sales tax relief days for hurricane supplies and back to school supplies. There will also be a third week of sales tax- free days in July for recreational supplies and entertainment tickets.

The first of these three tax breaks will be the disaster preparedness week from May 28 through June 3. Hurricane supplies such as coolers, batteries, weather radios and dozens of other items will be tax-exempt. Generators costing less than \$750 are also included in this sales tax-free event.

Then, in July, there will be a new tax-free holiday called Freedom Week. It will be held starting July 1st through July 7th, and includes camping and fishing gear, tents, sleeping bags, camp stoves, sunscreen, and more. Even folding camping chairs costing less than \$40 are on the list. There are some limits on price of individual items. For a complete list of items, and the price limits on each one, please check website: www.flsenate.gov/Media/PressReleases/Show/3971. You can also buy tax-free tickets to sporting events, museum visits, fitness memberships, movies, or music venues, but these must be used before the end of 2021. The goal of this new tax holiday is to encourage families to get back to 'normal' after a difficult year.

The "back-to-school" sales tax holiday, established in 2014, will be ten days long, from July 31 to August 9, 2021. Purchases included are clothing, footwear, and backpacks costing \$60 or less, school supplies costing \$15 or less, and the first \$1,000 of the sales tax price of personal computers or personal computer-related accessories.

Plan your summer shopping wisely to get the best tax relief on your purchases. Have a safe, fun-filled summer of 2021!!


Hurricane season begins June 1st and ends November 30th. More information on Hurricane Season preparedness will be included in the June newsletter.

This year, the National Hurricane Center will begin its forecast operations earlier, beginning May 15th

to alert for any possible tropical storms that could develop prior to the start of the official Hurricane Season. The reason for the early start is because named storms have formed before June 1st for the past six years. Due to this, experts are planning to determine whether the entire season should be moved to start in May instead of June. One major change to storm naming will take effect this year. The Greek alphabet will no longer be used to name storms if there are hyperactive years and all planned names are used. This

happened in 2005, and again last year, when there were 30 named storms and the Greek alphabet was used extensively. If 2021 is anything like last season, there could be more storms than the above listed 21 names. These are the additional names that will be used to replace the Greek alphabet.

A few reminders regarding our Community and Covenants:

- 1. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling is picked up Wednesdays. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept on any Lot except in sanitary containers or garbage compactor units. Garbage containers, if any, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be so placed or screened as not to be visible from any road or adjacent property within sight distance of the Lot. **Trash, refuse and garbage shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pickup.**
- 2. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Waste Management will NOT pick up any yard trash in plastic bags. If you have very large piles of branches and clippings, always call Waste Management ahead of Friday pickup to notify that you have a large amount. ALSO CALL DAVID AMBROSE—City of Melbourne Manager of the Waste Management contract. (321) 608-5081.
- 3. For Bulk Items: Contact Waste Management to schedule a bulk items pick up (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will return later in the day to pick up bulk items. For more information contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 4. Waste Management trucks are automated, manned by only one employee. Therefore, any trash NOT in the garbage bin WILL NOT be picked up.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, to include Roofs and Fences, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval BEFORE starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval, regardless of the current color.
