January 2022 Board Meeting

January 18, 2022

Minutes

Nancy called the meeting to order at 7:03PM with a quorum of four board members present.

Secretary's minutes from the last meeting in November 2021 were approved as published in the December 2021 newsletter. Financial reports for November and December, as published in the monthly newsletter, were approved.

The cracks in the Message Board door are increasing and getting larger. Board approved ordering a replacement metal door as soon as possible.

The fencing at the Wild Wood bike path has been compromised. Unknown person(s) illegally cut the chain link fence, which has allowed motorcycles, seen by various homeowners, to pass through into Wickham Forest. We are waiting on the City of Melbourne to give the okay to close the bike paths to all traffic. Temporary solutions such as concrete barricades to block the bike path are being pursued to restrict the traffic to pedestrians only.

No word from BSE on when the inspection of the weirs on the retention ponds will be scheduled. It may not be required to file with St. John's Water Management. Mary will call BSE to check up on inspection.

Pepper trees have invaded WF property at the entrance. Estimates are being sought from various companies to remove up to the WF property line.

The landscaping company has not been completing service as per the contract. Board members will search for a new lawn company and get estimates prior to the March meeting.

Board members will check on the pepper tree intrusion near the Bent Pine weir to determine if it is HOA responsibility or individual homeowners' responsibility.

The solar light on the Message Board has been installed. Suggestion was made to place a small barricade around the back of the light to protect it from vehicles that have access to the lot for service. Ideas will be submitted for review at the March Board meeting.

Plans were finalized for the Annual WFHOA Meeting to be held February 16, 2022, at Joe's Club. People will be contacted to assist with tallying votes.

A homeowner inquired about the possibility of the HOA paying for a tree the homeowner had removed in the past. The tree was on conservation area behind their home. No ARC approval was requested for their action. The HOA does not pay for tree removal on individual properties and would not have removed a tree in the conservation area without approval from St. Johns Management.

Cory will research with St. John's Management to determine how to proceed with a dead tree on the edge of the conservation area, and if it can be removed.

The WF Board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any Board member at: wickham-forest@googlegroups.com.

A few reminders regarding our Community and Covenants:

- 1. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling (yellow lid) is picked up Wednesdays. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept on any Lot except in sanitary containers or garbage compactor units. Garbage containers, if any, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be so placed or screened as not to be visible from any road or adjacent property within sight distance of the Lot. Trash, refuse and garbage shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pickup.
- 2. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Waste Management will NOT pick up any yard trash in plastic bags. If you have very large piles of branches and clippings, always call Waste Management ahead of Friday pickup to notify that you have a large amount. ALSO CALL DAVID AMBROSE—City of Melbourne Manager of the Waste Management contract. (321) 608-5081.
- 3. <u>For Bulk Items</u>: Contact Waste Management to schedule a bulk items pick up (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will return later in the day to pick up bulk items. For more information contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 4. Waste Management trucks are automated, manned by only one employee. Therefore, any trash NOT in the garbage bin WILL NOT be picked up.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan <u>any exterior changes</u>, to include Roofs and Fences, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval BEFORE starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval, regardless of the current color. Applications for ARC approval are available on the website at wickhamforest.com
- 6. In case you haven't heard, Wickham Forest residents have a great opportunity to stay informed with what is happening in our subdivision, as well as in the surrounding area.
