Mayor Paul Alfrey has been very involved with eradicating homeless camps and offering alternative choices for those living outdoors. Please don't hesitate to contact the City, as the Board has been in contact with the authorities as well.

March 2022 Board Meeting

March 16, 2022

Minutes

Nancy called the meeting to order at 7:02PM with a quorum of four board members present.

Secretary's minutes from the meeting in February were approved as published in the March newsletter. Financial reports for February, as published in the March newsletter, were approved.

The torn flag at the entrance has been replaced.

Delivery of the replacement door for the Message Board is expected soon.

Closing of the bike paths is still waiting on the City to advise. Board members will investigate what would be needed to at least repair the chain link fence that was destroyed by an unknown violator on the Wild Wood bike path.

Brevard Excavating will remove the pepper trees on the Bent Pine pond weir. Work will be completed as their schedule allows.

Changes to the ARC application to simplify and make it more user friendly are contingent upon the ARC committee recommendations.

Painting of the curb on the western Forest Run island is dependent upon weather and volunteers to assist. Please contact the Board if you are willing to help with this project.

Two landscape companies have been contacted and interviewed; open to receiving bids from them.

Board members will visit Rockledge Gardens to get advice on plants for the Message Board and Ligustrum tree planters. Diseased shrubs behind the Message Board will be replaced by the current landscaping company.

The Board welcomes Blain Morgan (chair) and Reda Rozanski as the newest members of the ARC. Additional volunteers are needed as one member is relocating and needs to be replaced.

Board members will contact homeowners who assisted last year to coordinate the decorating of the entrance at Christmas so that there isn't a scramble to design at the last minute.

Discussion held on of how much money should be collected through dues increases and set aside as a reserve fund for unforeseen emergencies such as repairs to culverts, ponds, and fences. Dues increases would be made annually to slowly reach a financial goal in place of having to levy a large amount per homeowner in an emergency assessment.

Frank will pursue contacting the county on the possibility of installation of a no U-turn sign on the north-bound side of Wickham at the entrance to Wickham Forest.

The entrance lights at the entrance should be on a timer but have been lit all the time. Jim will check on this and repairs, if needed, will be made as soon as possible.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:44pm

There will not be an April Board meeting. The next WFHOA Board meeting will be held at 7pm at Joe's Club on MAY 18, 2022.

Welcome New Residents!

The WF Board would like to welcome you to the community. If you do not have a copy of our Covenants and Deed Restrictions, or have any questions about them, please contact any Board member at: wickham-forest@googlegroups.com.

A few reminders regarding our Community and Covenants:

- 1. Garbage is picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. Recycling (yellow lid) is picked up Wednesdays. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept on any Lot except in sanitary containers or garbage compactor units. Garbage containers, if any, shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be so placed or screened as not to be visible from any road or adjacent property within sight distance of the Lot. Trash, refuse and garbage shall not be placed at curbside earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the evening before scheduled pickup.
- 2. Yard trash is picked up on Fridays. Yard trash should not be placed at the curb until the night before pick-up. Tree branches/shrub clippings, etc. need to be cut down to 4 foot sections and bundled for easier pick up by waste management. Waste Management will NOT pick up any yard trash in plastic bags. If you have very large piles of branches and clippings, always call Waste Management ahead of Friday pickup to notify that you have a large amount. ALSO CALL DAVID AMBROSE—City of Melbourne Manager of the Waste Management contract. (321) 608-5081.
- 3. For Bulk Items: Contact Waste Management to schedule a bulk items pick up (including furniture). These items can be placed at the curb on Fridays. The truck that picks up the yard trash will return later in the day to pick up bulk items. For more information contact Waste Management at 321-723-4455.
- 4. Waste Management trucks are automated, manned by only one employee. Therefore, any trash NOT in the garbage bin WILL NOT be picked up.
- 5. If you are planning to paint your home or plan any exterior changes, to include Roofs and Fences, please contact the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for approval BEFORE starting any new project. A sample of paint color, shingle type/color, plan layout, etc. must be submitted to the ARC for approval, regardless of the current color. Applications for ARC approval are available on the website at wickhamforest.com
- 6. In case you haven't heard, Wickham Forest residents have a great opportunity to stay informed with what is happening in our subdivision, as well as in the surrounding area.
